The Centre for Development Studies is an autonomous research centre sponsored by Government of Kerala and the Indian Council of Social Science Research. Established in 1970, its main activities are research, teaching and training on a range of ten different themes related to India and Kerala's economy and society. In terms of teaching it conducts a PhD programme in Economics and an MPhil and MA programmes in Applied Economics for all of which it is affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru University. The Centre has a resident faculty of about 20 supplemented with a number of visiting faculty. It has an excellent infrastructure; the most notable being its well-stocked library and its Wi-Fi friendly green campus.

The Centre invites applications for the above position. The Chair is instituted to conduct research in monetary and financial economics, banking, real sector issues, public finance and related areas of research interest to the Bank. The selected scholar is also required to be associated with the other two activities of the Centre, namely teaching and training.

The applicant should be (a) an eminent scholar with a Doctorate in Economics/Finance with evidence of published work of high quality in monetary economics, financial economics, banking, financial markets, financial sector regulation and macroeconomics and other related areas; (b) have minimum ten years of teaching and research experience in Universities/National Institutions including those from RBI, SEBI and other regulatory agencies (c) and be able to teach either economic theory or quantitative methods including economic theory at the graduate level. The maximum age limit is 65 years (as on April 30, 2019).

The Chair shall follow the guidelines contained in the Memorandum of Agreement signed between the Reserve Bank of India and the Centre in carrying out her duties and responsibilities.

The appointment will be in the Pay Band of Rs.37400-67000 with Academic Grade Pay of Rs.10000 (subject to revision according to 7th CPC). Other benefits include a seed money grant and campus housing subject to availability. Appointment will be initially for three years but extendable for another three years based on evaluation.
