The Centre has an active research programme on various themes in applied development economics and also offers highly rated Ph.D. and MA programme in Economics and Applied Economics respectively. The degrees are awarded by Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi. The Centre is currently inviting applications for the following positions:

- 1. Assistant Professor: (2 OBC NCL) Pay Band: Rs.15600-39100 (implementation of 7th CPC is under process)
- 2. Professor: (2 Un Reserved & 1 SC) Pay Band: Rs. 37400-67000, with the applicable AGP of Rs. 10000. (implementation of 7th CPC is under process)
- All selected candidates are entitled to a modest seed money grant and housing on campus.
- Preference will be given to those who can teach Microeconomics/ Econometrics/ Statistics/ Demography/ Environmental Economics/ Agricultural Economics/Topics in Development Economics at the Masters' and PhD levels, as well as supervise doctoral research scholars.
- They should be able to work in a multicultural research environment.
- The selected candidates are expected to join duty by the last week of October 2023.

## **Application Procedure:**

- 1. Applications should be submitted online following the instructions given on the website. http://cds.edu/jobs/. The last date for submission of the application is July 31, 2023
- 2. During the online application submission, please upload self-attested scanned copies of the following documents: (i) PG degree certificate and mark/grade sheets, (ii) Ph.D. degree certificate, (iii) Proof of date of birth, (iv) Document demonstrating 10 years of teaching experience / research experience (applicable for the post of Professors), (v) ANNEXURE Document (Format available on the website) detailing teaching and research experience, as well as publication details, (vi) Caste Certificate (for candidates applying for reserved category posts)
- 3. Applicants are not required to submit any hardcopies of documents.

- 1. Only Indian nationals need to apply. Applications from Indian nationals abroad will also be considered. If short listed, interviews may be held for Indian nationals abroad via video conferencing on the same day as in the other cases for the specified post.
